SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES

June 24, 2021

Chairman Paight called the meeting to order at 10:00 am. Selectman Nelson and Selectman Pitt were present. Also in attendance was Ellen Smith, Town Administrator.

Selectman Pitt moved and Selectman Nelson seconded a motion to approve the June 24, 2021 Accounts Payable Register in the amount of \$8,915.38 the Payroll Check Register in the amount of \$398.17 and the Direct Deposit Register in the amount of \$10,156.11, roll call vote Chairman Paight – yes Selectman Pitt – yes and Selectman Nelson – yes, motion passed.

Selectman Pitt moved and Selectman Nelson seconded a motion to approve the June 16, 2021 meeting minutes, roll call vote Chairman Paight – yes Selectman Pitt – yes and Selectman Nelson – yes, motion passed.

The Board approved and agreed to sign the following:

- Solar Exemption – Map 05-029
- Building permit application Map 11-039 pending approval by Building Inspector
- Unlicensed dogs – Civil Forfeiture

The Board discussed concerns raised over the condition of the pavilion and the usage of the ball fields. There have been questions as to why the light are kept on at all times and it was noted that a floor drain cover is missing.

Selectman Nelson moved and Selectman Pitt seconded a motion to execute the Settlement Agreement with Consolidated Communications of Northern New England Company, LLC to finalize the 2019 abatement case and further to have Chairman Paight sign the Agreement on behalf of the Board, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Pitt updated the Board on the possibility of a candidate to act as the Project Manager for Broadband who would keep the Town Administrator updated on the progress.
